CAMPS AND CLINICS

Based on a provisional opening date of Monday 6th July, we plan to run 2 weeks of camps and clinics focusing on tumbling, jumps and fitness only, with full social distancing measures in place.

These will be a great opportunity for preparing for trials and meeting the UA staff! Information on how to book onto these will be released on our social media platforms.

TRIALS: STAGE 1

Trials to assess tumbling, jumps and dance will provisionally take place the week beginning 20th July. Following these, athletes will be placed by age and tumble ability for a summer training schedule.

Potential non-tumble team athletes will still be required to attend and be assessed on dance, jumps, strength and fitness.

SUMMER TRAINING

Summer training will focus on tumbling, fitness, jumps and endurance and will follow social distancing measures. Non-tumble athletes will focus on fitness and strength based stunt specific workouts. New skills mastered during this time will be taken into account for team placements. Costs and schedule can be found on the next page.

TRIALS: STAGE 2

As soon as it is safe to engage in close contact sports we will hold our stage 2 trials. These will involve stunt/ building based assesments. The stunt trial, your stage 1 assessment and summer training progress will be used to then place you on your competition team for the remainder of the season.

In order to ensure that these teams are excelling in their respective divisions they train intensively and a high level of commitment is expected. All athletes offered a place on a Worlds team are expected to commit to attending the World Championships.

The provisonal dates for the Worlds trip will be Friday 16th April to Thursday 29th April 2021. We will offer a travel package covering flights, accommodation, transport and entry for the competition to keep costs as low as possible. We estimate costs to be around £1300 per person for the trip payable through a monthly payment plan starting in September.

Sadly Lemon are unable to travel to Spain in June to compete at Future Cheer Barcelona. However we are delighted to be able to offer this opportunity once again for 202! Lemon will be an International Junior Level 1 team open to athletes who are aged between 10 to 16 at any point during 2021.

Travelling abroad as part of a team is an incredible experience. Athletes who made Lemon last season will be given priority to participate once again however there will also be additional spaces available. Training for Lemon will work slightly differently this year, with training commencing on Sunday afternoons in April 2021 and culminating with a 3 day intensive training camp in the half term before the athletes depart for Barcelona on the Thursday evening.

Lemon will depart for Barcelona on the evening of Thursday 3rd June and return late on Sunday 6th June 2021. Anticipated cost of the trip is around £400. Please note that this trip is completely optional and there will be no fundraising for travel costs, however a manageable monthly payment plan will be put in place. Further information on trials and training costs will be released in September.

AN AFFORDABLE SEASON

What are we doing for our families and prospective new athletes post Covid-19?

Our priority will be to re-establish the gym as the place it was - a home to all of our families and their athletes where they can learn, develop, flourish, be part of a team and make friends and life long memories. We want every single one of our athletes to be able to return and new athletes to be able to join us, so we have looked into several options to save money where possible.

Fees Freeze

Moving into our new facility last year brought a noticeable increase in overheads, but we froze fees with the view to review and potentially increase for the 2020-2021 season. However, we will continue this fees freeze for the upcoming season with no additional unnecessary costs added.

Uniforms

As the age grid is changing so that all athletes remain within their current age groups for an additonal season we will be keeping the same uniforms for another year. We will work with all of you via the team mums to source second hand uniforms for those who need them.

Music

As the majority of our athletes had only competed once we are going to keep all of our music for the new season. The mixes will require an edit and will need to be re-licensed but music is incredibly expensive so we are able to cut costs here.

Membership package

We will be looking to reduce the membership cost where possible despite a rise in insurance costs (covers practise wear, insurance, choreography and music). We will be offering a reduced cost membership option for returning members including a new team tshirt but no shorts or a scrunchie. Shorts and scrunchies will be available to purchase separately throughout the season - please note these are uniform items that all athletes must have.

Choreography and camps

Where possible teams will keep a lot of the same choreography and we will prioritise doing as much as possible in house. Our Worlds teams will focus on edits as opposed to entire new routines. We will still look at including one affordable stunt camp for the Junior and Senior teams.

Competitions

We will not be adding any additional competitions to our schedule; it will remain the same as it was for the 19-20 season. We have credit for ICC Nationals so there will be no payment due for that for returning members (excluding new crossovers).

We also notice each year that families may over order on spectator tickets which are one of the higher costs, so we would encourage families to only order what is needed to try to save here.
